Notes: A lot of the numbering and text is modified to suit 45-65 verses per day reading plan i.e put into readable portions. Use bookmarks in your Bible at each Gospel. Date each 'day' section read. Allow 63 days to read through it. Notice the Apostle's emphasis by single-line events with a large number of verses like #-s 78 & 96 or two-line events like 88, 111, 165, 183, 235, 237.
